To maintain best practices of public safety, Creative Classes is implementing these new policies. They are mainly operational so we can ensure we can safely offer in person classes. Creative Classes has put these policies in place to support the health and well-being of the community. As conditions change, Creative Classes may adjust this agreement.

Policies for COVID-19:

*New- Summer 2021: we will be following the host location/school's policies for COVID-19. Depending on the location, some things below may change, but many will stay intact. Feel free to reach out to us for any questions, and we will email updates as they become available.

1. Maximum of 15 students allowed per class/camp.
2. Parent/ Legal Guardian complete all forms when you check your child in with us at the first class and every class thereafter.
3. For social distancing, we will limit the number of students per table and each will be 6' apart.
4. Building supplies will be distributed to each student so there is no sharing or touching of the same items. No teams. Students must return all supplies before leaving class that day.
5. All staff and students must always wear masks properly. Any student arriving without a mask won't be permitted to attend the class, and the parent will be contacted for immediate pick up. Sorry, no refunds on our mask policy.
6. Sanitizer stations are available in every classroom, and staff and students must sanitize hands every time they enter the classroom.
7. Equipment is sanitized twice (2x) per day, once before class and again after our class.
8. Temperature checks will be performed on all students and staff and must be below 100.4 to enter the class.
9. To limit exposure, we will only be allowing the teacher and students in the classroom; no parents.
10. Sign-in & out procedures will be contactless this year. Our teachers will be using the Remind App to check-in and check-out all students for each class. *Parents will be required to have the Remind App on their smart phone.*
11. Students and staff are sent home to quarantine for 11 consecutive days if they have 1 "more common symptom" or 2+ "less common symptoms." More common symptoms include fever 100.4+, new or worsening cough, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell. Less common symptoms include sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, chills, muscle pain, excessive fatigue, severe headache, nasal congestion, or runny nose.
12. Students and teachers living with anyone who exhibits 1 "more common symptom" or 2+ "less common symptoms" must also quarantine for 11 consecutive days.
13. Any student who did not attend school on our class day is not permitted to attend our class after school.
14. If the class/course is interrupted for any reason, we will finish it remotely.
15. All staff are fully vaccinated.
